

Growing Food Citizens: Sunflower Project

Care for Sunflowers at Home

In your child's class they are taking part in a new project to share food growing skills by learning about the lifecycle of the Sunflower

Pupils are requested to bring into class a clean empty container e.g. margarine tub/toilet roll tube/ milk carton/ pot
In order to plant their seeds.

Children will look after plant in school until it has grown enough to be able to take it home in approx June.

They will share the Sunflower's story with their class, by keeping a photo diary or journal to describe what happens.
You may need to help your child with planting out the Sunflower at home in an outside space as it continues to grow or into a larger pot.
